In 2025, we impacted 8,879 patient lives through cell therapy—more than any other year since our founding in 1987.

PATIENT AND DONOR SUPPORT

NMDP provides one-on-one support for both donors and patients at every step of the transplant journey. Our comprehensive services including patient education, counseling, transplant navigation support, our NMDP Peer Connect program and much more—completely free of charge.

We also know that financial costs continue to be the number one burden or barrier reported by patients who come to us needing a transplant.*

In 2025, we provided patient assistance grants to more than 3,400 patients and their caregivers/families, totaling more than \$7 million. Much of this critical lifeline is funded through philanthropy and the generous support of our community.

RESEARCH

With the help of philanthropy, we conduct critical research with a focus on improving and delivering equitable outcomes for patients. In 2025, approximately 195 research studies and clinical trials were underway through CIBMTR® (Center for International Blood and Marrow Transplant Research®), a research collaboration between the Medical College of Wisconsin® and NMDP.

We also sponsor early-career researchers through the NMDP Amy Strelzer Manasevit Research Program. With the support of our philanthropic community, we've invested more than \$13 million to fund 53 Amy Scholars since 1998. The Amy Scholars have leveraged this funding to develop their research portfolios and win more than \$250 million in additional grant funding to support more discoveries that improve survival rates and quality of life for transplant patients.

GROWING THE REGISTRY

NMDP manages the world's most diverse registry of volunteer blood stem cell donors. Each year, we focus on growing the optimal registry, adding more young and ethnically diverse potential donors so more patients can find their best match for treatment. In 2025, more than 230,000 new potential donors joined the NMDP Registry.

Many programs critical to our life-saving mission are funded through the generous support of our philanthropic community. In 2025, NMDP supporters gave more than \$20 million to accelerate progress in research and expand access to treatment—so we can deliver on our mission to save more lives through cell therapy. **Because with NMDP, good goes a long way.**
